Step 1: Carry out a COVID-19 Risk Assessment

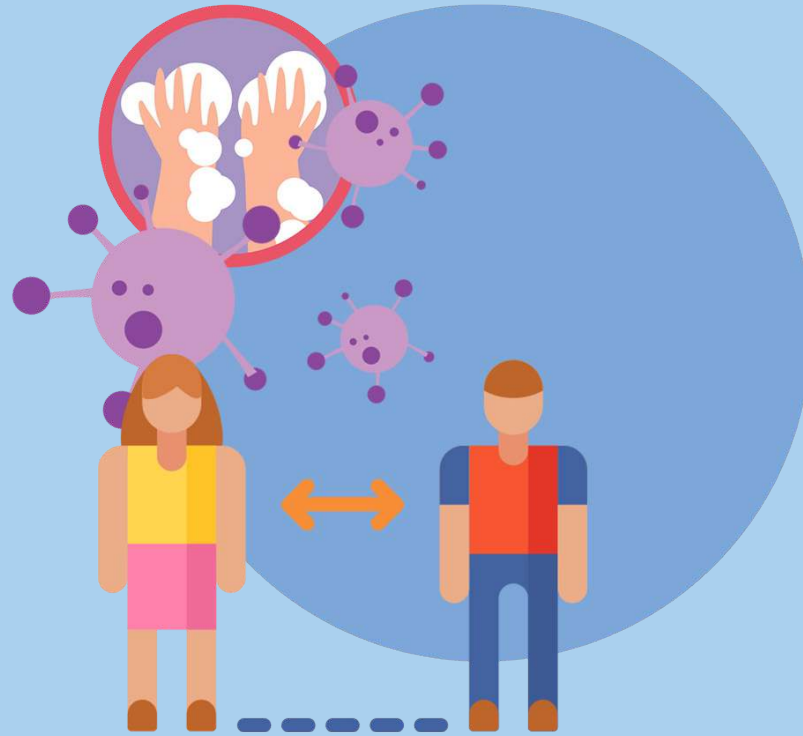
The best place to start is at the beginning! Assessing your current situation, in line with HSE guidance, will give you the best possible chance to successfully carry out a safe working environment.
